

Bryan Robert "Bobby" Johnson

Bryan Robert "Bobby" Johnson, age 81, of Rock Hill, SC, formally of Lavale, MD and Moorefield, WV, passed this life on Sunday, June 1, 2014 at the Carolinas Medical Center in Pineville, NC. Bobby was born on October 29, 1932 in Frostburg, MD and was the son of the late Bryan C. Johnson and Pearl Arnold Johnson.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sister, Jackie Johnson.
